I would firstly like to congratulate the Year 11's on their effort and conduct throughout the mock exams which come to a close on Friday 13th December.

Attendance in the final week of term is essential as there are a range of intervention sessions running, for completion of controlled assessment as follows:

Thursday 19th December	All Day - Photography, Textile and Art

Normal lessons will continue in the last week of term in all other subjects and it is vital that Y11 do not miss this curriculum time. The Meadowhall trip is also running on Thursday 19th December.

Y11 students will not attend school on Friday the 20th December. Their last day before Christmas will be Thursday 19th December. Our return to school in January is on Monday 6th January. Unusually next year we will return on Monday and will be closed to students for staff training on Friday 10th of January. This is to mitigate the number of Mondays that are lost due to bank holidays in 2025 with Easter Monday actually falling on the Monday after the two week Easter break. Please be aware that some students have an external sports studies exam in the first week back which will count for their final grade.
