

Uniform Requirements



Blouse, Shirt

Students in all year groups must wear a plain white, collared blouse/shirt, which buttons to the neck.

Jumper

Students across all year groups can wear a black v-neck jumper under their blazer, if they wish. This is optional.

Round neck jumpers, sweatshirts and hoodies are not allowed.

Trousers, Skirts

All students must wear plain, black, formal, straight-leg trousers OR a knee-length skirt.

Skirts **must** be knee-length. They may not be tight or in a stretchy material. Plain black tights may be worn with skirts.

Trousers must be plain, full-length, without decorations or accessories (including zips). **Leggings, jeggings, flared trousers, chinos, or jeans are not allowed.**

Shoes, Socks

All students must wear plain, black, formal shoes, without logos, brandings, or markings. All shoes must be flat.

Platforms and high heels are not allowed in school.

Socks should be plain and black

Trainers of any kind including Nike AirForce and canvas shoes such as 'Vans' and 'Converse' are not acceptable.

Jewellery

One small stud per lobe is allowed as well as a watch.

All other jewellery is not allowed in school. This includes necklaces, bracelets, hooped earrings, body and facial piercings.

Hairstyles, Make-Up, Nails

Nails must be a short, safe length. **The school does not allow false or acrylic nails.** We allow natural make-up.

False eyelashes are not allowed and pupils will be asked to remove them. Eyelashes should be of natural appearance. If your child wears excessive make-up, they will be asked to clean it off.

We accept a wide range of hairstyles. All we ask is that a student's hair is smart and of natural colour. **Undercuts are not allowed.**

Headscarves

Headscarves may be worn for religious reasons. They must be fully black and fastened securely allowing for lanyards to be on display.

Students who wear a headscarf during PE lessons should ensure they are securely fastened and not with a pin, preferably an all-in-one scarf.





Uniform Requirements

PE Kit

All students must wear an NSG PE top.

SHORTS Students must wear plain black shorts or plain black, full length, thick lycra sports leggings or the NSG skort.

TRAINERS Students must have a pair of trainers to change into however, trainers must not be worn to any other lessons.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS Students can also wear additional items for outdoor lessons, such as plain black jogging bottoms.

School Tie

Students must wear a tie with their school uniform. These are clip-on and can be purchased in two lengths.

Mobile devices

We operate a 'phone free' school environment. If you wish your child to have a mobile device for safety reasons on their way to school, please ensure that your child turns it off before entering the school site and does not use it during the school day until they have left school premises.

Should your child use it in school, it will be removed and if this happens twice, a parent is required to collect it. The same rules apply for all smart devices, incl. smart watches.

Equipment

Students need a bag everyday with their pencil case including, as a minimum, black or blue ink pens or biro, pencil, ruler, eraser, a red pen, a purple pen, a highlighter as well as a calculator. Students will be given a school planner. Their bag, equipment and planner must be with them everyday.

Lanyard

All students must wear their student lanyard and student ID cards at all times when on the school site, unless permitted to remove it for practical activities or exams. Students must not deface the card on the lanyard.

We sell Newland School for Girls uniform through the school website.

The school has worked to ensure that all items of uniform are as affordable as possible. Parents who have difficulty purchasing the uniform should contact the school to discuss available support. We also have a preloved stand in the main reception that parents can also take advantage of.

If you are unsure about suitable styles of uniform, please call your child's Pastoral Mentor who will be happy to clarify what is acceptable. The school will have the final decision on all uniform issues. Failure to meet our uniform expectations will result in sanctions should the uniform not be rectified.
